TRAVEL SUGGESTIONS

The wedding ceremony is taking place in my hometown of Endicott, with the reception in Johnson City, NY – both close suburbs of Binghamton, NY.

As you may have surmised, the Binghamton Airport is not very big, and therefore does not accommodate many jet flights. If you are within a 6-hour drive, we would recommend driving. The distance between Washington, DC, and Binghamton, NY, is approximately 300 miles, or 5.5 hours of drive time (in decent traffic). In September, it should be a pretty drive through the mountains of Pennsylvania.

However, if you would prefer to fly, here is some information that may be of help to you in your travel planning...

There are plenty of prop flights into and out of Binghamton. For those of you who do not like to fly on props, the Binghamton Airport (BGM) accommodates the following limited jet flights through Pittsburgh on US Airways on 50-seat Enbraer jets (as of March, 2003):

- Friday, 9/19: Departing PIT at 1:10p, landing at BGM at 2:15p
- Friday 9/19: Departing PIT at 10:05p, landing at BGM at 11:10p
- Sunday, 9/21: Departing BGM at 7:15a, landing at PIT at 8:27a
- Sunday, 9/21: Departing BGM at 3:00a, landing at PIT at 4:12p

Note: Although most of the major airlines do have some flights into and out of Binghamton, American Airlines does NOT fly to or from Binghamton.

The next best airport to fly into is the Syracuse airport (SYR). The Syracuse airport is right on Route 81, and an easy 75-minute drive to/from Binghamton (just hop on I-81 South at the airport). Syracuse hosts more airlines and many more flight options.

The rates listed include shuttle transportation to/from the reception. The reception is less than 2 miles away from the hotel. There is a complimentary continental breakfast each morning until 11am. That means if you're coming in from out of town, plan on arriving at the hotel by 4pm in order for you to get settled, try on your tux at the shop, and get to the rehearsal on time.

A double-gym was added to the main building in 1951. The club has been going through various renovations since 1998, but retains most of its mid-1900's charm.

Although Lu had always pictured her wedding reception to be at some posh hotel or at a local bed-and-breakfast or winery, having the reception at the Heritage Country Club holds some personal sentiment. - Harry L. Drive turns into Watson Boulevard past Hoss's
- You will pass a pink "Gingerbread House" on the left
- The Heritage Country Club is approximately 1/2 mile up Watson Boulevard on your right hand side
 - o You'll see many white fuel tanks on the left as you approach
 - You can park in either lot:
 - The lot to the right of the club (by the swimming pool), OR
 - The lot to the left of the club (after going under the bridged pedestrian walkway to the ball fields)
 - o Enter the building at the brick house

Directions from the Church

- Head back down Odell Avenue
- Take a left onto Watson Boulevard
- Stay straight on Watson Boulevard for approximately 3.5 miles
- After heading out of the residential areas and passing Country Club Road (which will be on your left), the Heritage Country Club will be on your left
- Park in the lot on either side of the building, and enter the building at the brick house

Note that no one will be allowed into the reception ballroom until 5PM. If you arrive early, feel free to have a look around the club or the grounds. They may let you use the game room for a minimal fee, if any charge at all (probably around \$5). Also, there is a Club House Café and a Club House Lounge, both in the back of the club overlooking part of the golf course, but they may not be open if it is a slow golf day.

The Cider Mill

Directions from Area Hotels:

- Head west on Harry L. Drive for approximately 4.5 miles
 - o As you drive down Harry L. Drive, the mall should be on your right, and Wegman's grocery store on your left
 - o Harry L. Drive turns into Watson Boulevard
- Cross Odell Avenue (this is the street where you would turn to go to the church)
- Take next left onto Oak Hill Avenue
- Take first right, at light, onto Franklin Street
- Take left, at light, onto Nanticoke Ave. (Route 26)
- You will see The Cider Mill on your right at the North Street intersection (big red barn-looking building)
 - o Look for "Entrance" signs, which might be just beyond the building

Jackson's Farm

Another local Fall tradition is visiting Jackson's Farm, a playground of life-like, almost-animated pumpkin statues surrounding a country store of Fall season goodies.

Directions from Area Hotels:

- From the area hotels, take 201S to 17 West
 - o (Reynolds Road turns into 201S at the main mall intersection)
- Take 17 West (4.2 miles)
- Take exit 67N (Route 26 North), towards Endicott (0.3 miles)
- Merge onto Route 26 North (0.4 miles)
- Take the Route 17C W / Main St / Route 26 N ramp (0.2 miles)
- Merge onto 17C W / East Main St / Route 26 N (1.2 miles)
- Stay on East Main Street, which will eventually turn into Route 17C West
- Jackson's Farm will eventually be on your right

- Turn right onto Front Street
- The Roberson Museum and Science Center will be on your right

- Follow So. Washington Street to the end and at the stop sign turn left onto Morgan Road
- Ross Park is 1/2 mile up the road on the right
